- Acceptance by a supervisor
- Completed 144 Units of Credit (UOC) (see i) below);
- Achieved a credit average across 6 Level III subjects of your stated Major/Minor;
- Completed 12 UOC of General Education included in the 144 UOC (see ii) below);
- Satisfied the requirements of the program/plan in which you are enrolled (see iii) below).

i) **WD, WC grades.** It is your responsibility to sort out with the course coordinator any unresolved grades of this nature and communicate this to your prospective supervisor and honours coordinator.

ii) **In single degrees you must complete 12 UOC of General Education.** Please be aware that general education rules for science students are determined by the Associate Dean. Please check general education enquiries with the Science Student Centre.

iii) **Satisfying the program/plan requirements means:**

- in Advanced Science completing Stages 1-3 of the Plan as specified in the Handbook,
- in ENVS completing the core and a discipline stream as specified,
- in the science program 3970 completing Stages 1-3 of at least a Major and a Minor as specified,
- for combined degrees you must have met the requirements of the pre-honours program as specified in the handbook.

2. You should discuss your interests and available projects with potential supervisors before completing this form (see BEES website for supervisor details). The choice you make here is not necessarily final and it will be possible to make changes to project or supervisor later.

5. You will be informed by e-mail late before the start of session if you are accepted into the honours program. You should then pick up a letter of admission for your enrollment from the BEES Student Office.

6. Academic Record: No academic record is required from students enrolled at UNSW. Non-UNSW students should attach or supply a copy of your academic record for your undergraduate studies with this form (and inform us any grades if you are currently enrolled in level III subjects).

This should be lodged with the UAC Admissions Office at UNSW (9385 3228), usually by early December for S1 start, and they will assess your grades and send to the School via the Associate Dean. You must submit an academic transcript with your application. If final results are not available when you submit this application you must forward them as soon as possible together with a statement indicating that you have completed all requirements for the degree and are eligible to graduate.
