

Labelling for specimens in chemicals

**** This information is specifically for the move to E26 through Allied Pickfords****

When packing for the move, Specimens in chemicals can be moved without extra packing they just need to be put together in trays/buckets.

Example 1. You have specimens in glass jars preserved in Ethanol and Formulin. Each jar should have a small label. The tray they are sitting in should have a chemalert label for the chemicals present. You can then place your Allied Pickfords stickers on each tray.



Example 2. You have multiple specimens in small vials or jars. Same as above the jars can all be placed in one tray/tub. Then the Allied Pickfords sticker on the tubs.
