- NOTE: THIS VESSEL ENTERED SURVEY PRIOR TO THE INTRODUCTION OF THE NATIONAL SYSTEM FOR DOMESTIC COMMERCIAL VESSELS ON THE 1ST OF JULY 2013.
- NOTE: THE TOTAL POWER OF THE OUTBOARD ENGINE/S NOT EXCEEDING 89KW.
- NOTE: VESSEL IS FITTED WITH 0.4 CUBIC METERS OF INTERNAL FOAM BUOYANCY.
- THE MASTER MUST ENSURE THAT THE VESSEL MUST NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED DURING DIVE OPERATIONS.
- FOR CLASS 2D: THE MAXIMUM DEAD WEIGHT OF PERSONNEL AND THEIR EQUIPMENT IS NOT TO EXCEED 995KG.
- FOR CLASS 2D DIVE OPERATIONS (WITH 1 CREW AND 4 SPECIAL PERSONS): SINGLE BOTTLE DIVES ARE PERMITTED ONLY.
- FOR CLASS 2C - THE OWNER AND MASTER MUST ENSURE THAT THE MAXIMUM LOADING OF PERSONS AND THEIR EFFECTS ON BOARD IS LIMITED TO 464KG.
- FOR CLASS 2C DIVE CHARTERS (WITH 1 CREW AND 3 SPECIAL PERSONS): THE VESSEL IS TO BE SOLELY USED IN THE DIVING PARTY SERVICE FOR THE TRAINING AND OPERATION OF DIVERS WITH ONLY CREW AND DIVERS BEING ON BOARD.
- FOR CLASS 2C WORKBOAT OPERATIONS (WITH 1 CREW AND 4 SPECIAL PERSONS) - THE OWNER AND MASTER MUST ENSURE THE VESSEL IS ONLY OPERATED Laterally along the coast within thirty (30) nautical miles of and within fifteen (15) nautical miles to seaward of the coast from sheltered waters or a safe haven.
- FOR CLASS 2C DIVE CHARTERS (WITH 1 CREW AND 3 SPECIAL PERSONS) - THE OWNER AND MASTER MUST ENSURE THAT THE VESSEL IS ONLY OPERATED Laterally along the coast within thirty (30) nautical miles of and within five (5) nautical miles to seaward of the coast from sheltered water or a safe haven.
- FOR CLASS 2C: THE OWNER AND MASTER MUST ENSURE THAT THERE IS NO SITTING OR POSITIONING OF WEIGHTS OR LOADINGS PERMITTED ON THE SOLID SIDE COLLARS.
- FOR 2C DIVE CHARTER (WITH 1 CREW AND 3 SPECIAL PERSONS) - THE MASTER MUST ENSURE THAT THE VESSEL MUST NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED DURING DIVE OPERATIONS.
- FOR CLASS 2C WORKBOAT (WITH 1 CREW AND 4 SPECIAL PERSONS) - THE VESSEL IS DEEMED TO SATISFY THE REQUIRED OUTCOMES OF THE STANDARD WITH RESPECT TO COMPASS ADJUSTMENT AS SET OUT IN THE NSCV C7C AS THE VESSEL IS LIMITED TO THE OPERATIONS OF 15NM TO SEAWARD OF THE COAST AND IS FITTED WITH ALTERNATIVE ELECTRONIC AIDS TO NAVIGATION. THIS VESSEL IS ALSO DEEMED TO SATISFY THE REQUIRED OUTCOMES OF THE STANDARDS WITH RESPECT TO THE REQUIREMENT TO CARRY A SCALE F FIRST AID KIT AS SET OUT IN THE NSCV C7A ON THE CONDITION THAT THE VESSEL OPERATES WITHIN 2 HOURS OF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE AND THE CONDITION THAT THE VESSEL CARRIES A SCALE G FIRST AID KIT WHICH IS DEEMED AS ADEQUATE FOR RENDERING FIRST AID FOR SINGLE INCIDENT EVENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH NSCV C7A H.3.2.
