SITE ASSESSMENT: The Steps (Inscription Point), Kurnell

Location/ Site: The Steps, Kurnell (Sometimes referred to Inscription Point.

Alternate site 'The Monuments' is also sometimes referred to as Inscription Point).

GPS: 34°00'11.6"S 151°13'31.6"E

Depth: 20m

Swell: Protected from S to SE swells up to 2-3 meters. Cannot dive here with N to ESE swell direction over 1 meter.

General Currents: Swell dependant and current can be moderate. Best to dive at slack or incoming. Can be done as a drift dive on incoming (see note regarding one-way dive below).

Entry / Egress: Shore. Good entry point is the small inlet just to the left at the bottom of the steps. If the swell and/or the tide is up; the "v" shaped groove next to this can also be used.

<u>Special Note:</u> This dive can be done as a one-way dive from The Leap to The Steps or from The Steps to The Monuments/Sutherland point. This should be done on an incoming tide.

Dominant Marine Species Identified: Kelp and urchin barrens with sponge gardens at depth. Weedy sea dragons!

Hazards Identified:

Visibility: Best to dive on incoming tide.

Boating: Carry a flag.

DMA: Sharks, blue ringed octopus, numb rays, urchins

<u>Sharps:</u> Rocky platform entry with sharp/abrasive rocks: Booties and gloves and full

wetsuit.

Not a sheltered water site: Must have shore support at all times.


